Conquering Childhood Cancer

Connor's Heroes exists to make life easier for children who must endure cancer treatment, as well as for their families. Founded in 2006 as a salute to Connor Goodwin, who triumphed after 2 ½ years of cancer treatment as a preschooler, Connor's Heroes developed out of one family's struggle with childhood cancer. Their personal experience has informed Connor's Heroes' provision of individualized support to over 1,000 children with cancer and their families in the last nine years.

By building relationships of trust with patients and their families, Connor's Heroes helps each family identify needs and then responds quickly and appropriately by engaging community volunteers in personal support services. Four primary programs have been developed in the last eight years to remove stressors and support patients and families. These programs are:

- <u>Heroes Bags & Backpacks</u> provides age-appropriate, practical and comforting supplies and resources to patients and families at the time of diagnosis.
- <u>Superheroes and Sidekicks™</u> eases the isolation and burden of cancer by matching children (either patients or siblings of patients) with trained mentor buddies.
- <u>Bone Marrow Transplant Unit Support</u> services include patient room decorating, the Room of Possibilities where families can enjoy time together, patient gifts, and friendly visits.
- <u>Helping Heroes Program</u> provides support services such as coordination of meal delivery, grocery shopping, housework, and transportation.

Connor's Heroes also established, and continues to providing funding for the Connor's Heroes Pediatric Cancer Research Fund at the VCU Massey Cancer Center. The endowment will be used exclusively to support pediatric cancer research with the ultimate goal of recruiting a nationally recognized pediatric cancer researcher.

Currently, Connor's Heroes provides assistance to children and their families who are being treated for cancer in Richmond, Virginia at the Children's Hospital of Richmond at VCU and the VCU Massey Cancer Center Bone Marrow Transplant Unit. On average, 100 families receive services through Connor's Heroes each year.

## Braxton Harmon

Braxton is just over a year old and lives with his family in the Richmond area. He is a brave and strong little boy!

- He is being treated at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, but is seen weekly at MCV
- He receives laser treatments to his eyes and chemo monthly
- He has tumors in both eyes, anticipate vision in his left eye will be good, the right eye is unknown. It is also too early to tell if he will keep this eye.
- His type of cancer is genetic and predisposes him to various other cancers throughout his life
